Application of the Principal, Ahmednagar Homoeopathic Medical College, Savedi Road, Ahmednagar-414003 Maharashtra seeking permission of the National Sub: Commission for Homeopathy to increase of seats 75 to 100 seats in Under Graduation course for the academic session 2021-22 under Section 12A of HCC Act, 1973 LoI - reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to your application dated 23/09/2020 received from the Ministry through its letter No.R-14013/5/2020-EP-II dated 30.09.2020 and to say that the proposal has been considered in this Medical Assessment and the Rating Board and inspection was carried out to examine the application on 16/02/21

- After considering the report of inspection carried out by Central Council for Homeopathy on 23.02.2021, the competent authority has decided to issue Letter of Intent (LoI) to increase of seats 75 to 100 seats in Under Graduation Course at Ahmednagar Homoeopathic Medical College, Savedi Road, Ahmednagar-414003. Maharashtra Section 12A of HCC Act, 1973 from the academic session 2021-22 subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before the inspection by the CCH regarding the matter for consideration for issuance of Letter of Permission (LoP) for the academic session 2021-22, failing which Letter of Permission (LoP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LoI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn:
 - The college shall appoint all full time teachers and Guest Faculties in prescribed subjects (i) and fulfill all the Minimum Standards Requirements in respect of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in "Homeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homeopathic Colleges and attached Hospital) Regulations, 2013, as amended up to 2019.
 - The college shall maintain genuinely functional hospital with required average number of (ii) patients in OPD and IPD with required bed occupancy etc.
 - The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely "Establishment (iii) of New Medical College (Opening of New Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College) Regulations, 2011" (as amended up to 2018) and Homeopathy (Degree Course) BHMS Regulations, 1983 (as amended up to 2019), before inspection for considering issuance of letter of permission.
 - The applicant shall fulfill the requirement of all the relevant provisions under the HCC (iv) Act, 1973.
 - On examining the college is having following deficiencies which shall be rectified within (v) 10 days from the date of receipt of this letter. The deficiencies are as under:
 - i. Dr. Sapana Premchand Muthiyan, Guest Professor, acquittance not available.
 - ii. Dr. Prashant Kutal, Lecturer- completed BHMS in 2006 and date of joining as lecturer is 19/8/07. Four years of professional experience not completed before joining as lecturer after BHMS.

- iii. Dr. Deepali Bhushan Shelke, Guest Professor, acquaintance not available.
- iv. Dr. Punam Bhawar, Lecturer- completed BHMS in 2006 and date of joining as lecturer is 17/7/08. Four years of professional experience not completed before joining as lecturer after BHMS

The applicant is also required to submit the requisite performance bank guarantee of Rupees 50 Lakh only (required for increase of seat @ Rs. 50.00 lakhs) valid for a period of 4 ½ years in favour of National Commission for Homoeopathy or to furnish undertaking to provide funds in their Plan Budget regularly till the requisite facilities are fully provided as specified under the section 6 (3) (h) of notified Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2011 (as amended up to 2018).

- 4 The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted against the above mentioned increased seats of BHMS course till the formal permission by issue of Letter of Permission (LoP) of the Central Government is granted.
- 5. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent, the LoI would automatically lapse and be treated cancelled without further reference to the applicant college.
- 6. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
- 7. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
